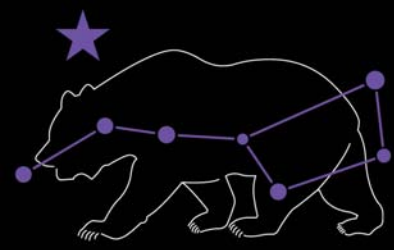
California Space Enterprise Speakers Bureau

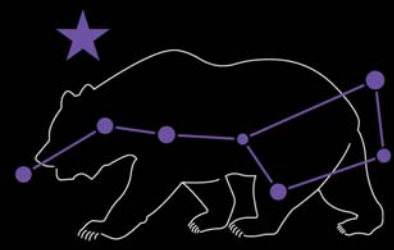
Space Space

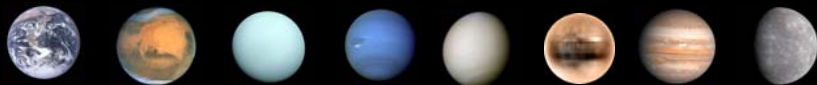


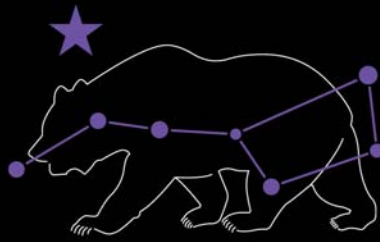
